Secret Online Places To Find Things To Sell

Hey guys, in this video we are going to talk about secret online places to find things to sell.

This is for those of you who may not live near a Goodwill or a Re-Store or a Goodwill Bins. Or if you'd rather run your eBay business solely from your home instead of venturing out to find deals, then this video is for you.

Okay, now, let's take a look at these sites so you can see for yourself why they can be goldmines for finding things to sell on eBay.

The first place is the Biglots weekly clearance site.

And just a side note, all of the links to these websites are listed below so don't worry about trying to manually copy the link from the screen.

Okay, this is the clearance site for the Biglots discount store. What you want to look for are the big savings deals. Deals that are 50% off or more. Then, when you find a deal, look it up on eBay to see if it's being sold for the normal price.

Here's an example. I checked this Brown 3-Piece All Weather Wicker Folding Bistro Set listed for 69.99. It's 53% off. I copied the name of the product, then did a search on eBay and found that it's being sold for \$120. So you could order that product and resell it on eBay for a profit.

Another website I recommend is the Sams Club Auctions website.

And it works similar to eBay in that you bid on an item and then if you win, you make the purchase.

Now, I want to say, before you purchase an item to resell on eBay, make sure the markup on eBay is enough to make a profit. That means you have to factor in shipping costs too.

For instance, if you buy something for \$20 and it sells on eBay for \$25, that may not be worth it to go through the trouble of buying it and reselling it.

However, let's go back to our BigLots example. The Brown 3-piece folding bistro set is selling for \$69.99. So we'd want to add it to cart to see how much the shipping cost is. Okay, so looking at the shopping cart, I see my total is going to be about 90 bucks. Now, if you look at the eBay listing, this person is selling the item for 120.00 with a 10 shipping charge. So if you ran a similar listing and made the sale, you'd end up with about a \$30 profit. Not too shabby. You could also increase the shipping cost, or sell the item for a little more maybe \$130 or even \$140 to increase your profit. It may take longer to sell that way, but if it does sell, you'll make a larger profit.

Of course, you don't have to go with larger items like furniture.

Let's look at another secret site for an example of a smaller item.

Here is the ShopGoodwill.com site. This is an auction site where you can buy Goodwill products online.

Look at this pioneer sc-55 9.1 channel elite a/v receiver. There's only about a day left on the auction and the bids are only at \$39.00. Now the bidding may raise the price before the auction is over, but, if you look at what this product is going for on eBay, it's \$215.92. And they're selling it for Parts only.

So, if the auction doesn't go much higher, you could buy it and resell it for a large profit.

Another site, and this is one of my personal favorites, is Sierra Trading post. The site is Sierra.com.

And it sells just about everything. You can find some killer deals on clothing and gear. I actually buy most of my own clothign from this site. If I scroll down immediately I'm seeing deals up to 77% off. Let's look at this Marmot Lightray Gore-Tex Ski Jacket. It's 66% off, sellingn for \$109 and retails for \$325. If we look for this product on eBay we can see that it's selling Brand New for \$251.07 and \$21.29 shipping. So that item could potentially provide a pretty hefty profit.

Okay, the next secret site is dollartree.com. Now, dollar tree is a little different because they essentially sell most of their products for \$1.00. Because of this, you have to purchase a minimum amount. For example, look at this product, the Gold Plastic Charger Plates with Beaded Rims. You have to purchase it either by the Case for \$36 or per unit with the minimum being 4 units.

So, if you find a product on Dollar Tree that is selling for a higher price on eBay, you'll have to determin if it's worth buying more than one of that product.

I don't use Dollar Tree that often, mainly because a lot of what they sell is offbrand, meaning it's not what people are normally searhcing for, so it's hard to find products that will sell with a higher marked up price on eBay.

Okay, the final secret site you can use to purchase products to sell on eBay is the Costco online offers site.

And it's the same here as with the other sites, just browse through, look for good, hefty discounts, check eBay to see if it's selling at the regular price, and then determine if the profit will be large enough to make the purchase.

And that's it.

You can use these sites to supplement your other eBay listings or you can use them exclusively. Just remember to make sure that the profit potential on eBay is large enough to warrant making a purchase.
